

VIRGINIA INTERNATIONAL POLO CLUB POLICIES

Prior to any play; every member of every team must including substitutes must:

- SIGN ALL FORMS; 1) Application and 2) Hold Harmless Waiver
- REMIT PAYMENT; All Greens Fees and League Dues paid in full prior to June 1, 2010

1) UMPIRING: Every team will be required to provide qualified players to umpire games. Any substitutions must be cleared with management. Players in the first game of the day will umpire the second game and visa versa. On days with only one game, players from other teams in the league will be required to umpire. **ALL PLAYERS ARE TO RESPECT THE UMPIRES' CALLS AND ALL UMPIRES ARE TO FOLLOW THE PLAY AND KEEP THE GAMES SAFE AND FAIR.**

2) PLAYING SUBSTITUTES: Must be cleared with management prior to play. Grooms are not qualified substitutes unless registered with the USPA and approved by management.

3) FIELD MAINTENANCE: All players **MUST** replace divots after **ALL** games and remove all litter from premises.

4) TARDINESS AND UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT: will not be tolerated and may be subject to fines or rejection from the game or the league without refund.

5) STICK AND BALL: is NOT permitted on game fields other than warming up for game.

6) PROFESSIONAL PLAYER: Is defined as someone whose primary source of income is from playing polo.

7) MEMBERSHIP MAY BE REVOKED: should any or all of the above rules be violated. Greens fees and dues are non-refundable.

8) GREEN FEES / LEAGUE DUES / USPA ENTRY FEES: non-refundable

9) UNCOLLECTED FEES: Member is responsible for ALL fees related to any uncollected fees; including but not limited to bank fees, legal fees, interest (1.5% per month) from the date charges incurred.

10) ACCOUNTS IN ARREARS: All accounts more than 30 days in arrears are subject to 1.5% interest per month from the date the charge is incurred plus all attorney fees and any fees related to collection of fees.

11) THE MANAGER OF LLANGOLLEN reserves the right to exclude any invitee of VIPolo from Llangollen. This right includes but is not limited to; charity events, polo matches, farm tours, private parties, etc.

12) Virginia International Polo Club reserves the right to revoke membership should any and / or all of the above rules be violated. Greens fees, dues and USPA entry fees are non-refundable.

13) PROVIDE PROOF of a) negative coggins and b) USPA membership for USPA tournaments

Rules and Penalties

Release; unsigned	not permitted to play until signed	n/a
League Fees; unpaid	team not scheduled until paid	n/a
USPA Membership; not current	not permitted to play until current	n/a
Umpiring; no show	not permitted to play until fine paid	\$100.00
Umpiring; unsportsmanlike conduct	not permitted to play until fine paid	\$100.00/player
Umpiring; late	not permitted to play until fine paid	\$50.00/player
Player; unsportsmanlike conduct	not permitted to play until fine paid	\$100.00/player
Substitutes; if not approved 24 hours prior to play	unapproved substitute not permitted to play	\$100.00/team
**Team no show	not permitted to play until fine paid	\$1,000.00/team
**Player no show	not permitted to play until fine paid Player responsible for any fees related to scheduled game	\$100.00
Tardiness	ball will be bowled in 20 minutes after game time even if less than 4 players per team fines begin after 3 rd late arrival	\$50.00/player
Litter; failure to remove from facility		\$50.00/vehicle-trailer

*All fines will be doubled every time the same infraction occurs by the same player, e.g. 2nd umpire no show; \$200.00 fine.

** Team or player automatically disqualified from league after 2nd failure to show up for scheduled game.

Management will only communicate with team captain regarding scheduling games and umpires and team captain will be responsible for assigning a team member to umpire. If team captain is not available team captain will inform management who the substitute captain shall be.

Member is responsible for ALL fees related to uncollected funds; including but not limited to bank fees, legal fees, interest (1.5%) per month from the date the charges incurred.

Accounts in arrears; all accounts more than 30 days in arrears are subject to 1.5% interest per month from the date the charges incurred plus all attorney fees and any other fees related to collection of fees.
